Superintendent Report:

HS Principal Report by Megan Madson:

Choice Ready was discussed: the definition of Choice Ready by DPI is: Choice Ready is a new component in the North Dakota Accountability system to measure whether our high schools are producing students who are ready for success upon graduation. The Choice Ready data accounts for 21% of the high school's accountability. There are 4 main components which are essential skills, post secondary ready, work force ready and military ready.

Work Keys was discussed for all students.

Elementary Principal Report:

Enrollment is at 168 and attendance is 96% for the month of September. Because of the weather, teachers attending the Fall Educators Conference will be coming back early.

NWEA testing has started and results are immediate. Students are beginning to realize the importance of testing. Teachers had a pep rally to help motivate them before testing. Comparisons were made from last year's test and if students turned their tests in too quickly, they were able to stop and go to a different and take the test. Changing the environment for some students allowed them to complete testing.

Ms Madson showed the Board how to navigate the DPI website and how to get information on the dashboard.

Both schools have been identified as Targeted Support.

Picture day was the 2nd. Parent teacher conference was the 17th. Parent attendance was down this year.

PreK went to the Pumpkin Patch on the 16th. Quarter 1 awards ceremony is the 15th. Early childhood screening will be the 16th. Diabetes screening is the 24th.
