Chance Rush and his wife are coming once a month and work with Juniors/Seniors 30 minutes a day through Three Affiliated.

Elementary Principal Report:

Enrollment is at 166 and attendance is 97% for the month of October, with 22 students having perfect attendance.

November 20<sup>th</sup> will be Family Engagement night from 6-8 pm. Magic City Discovery center will be coming and doing hands on scientific activities with parents and students.

“Coffee Corner” will be starting 7:45am- 8:30am 2 days a week allowing parents when dropping their students to have coffee, cocoa and pastries and invite them to the morning book club, go into math classes visiting with the teachers on how to help their student at home.

November is Native American Heritage month and have scheduled activities 18 through 22<sup>nd</sup>.
