The tax levy meeting was held September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

Superintendent Sagert said that our taxable valuation did go up slightly, with a net increase of \$72,000. The mills will stay the same at 90.77. General fund will stay at 69.66 mills

Superintendent Report:

The 1<sup>st</sup> week of school we had around 60% capacity face to face. Some students on line are struggling. Overall went fairly well. Enrollment is up from last year. Administration talk daily as the situation can change quickly. Students have been wearing masks.

High School Principal:

Transitioning time is our biggest problem right now. Lunch time is difficult to social distance while standing in line for food. As with most schools, there is not enough room in that area. Students are spread out and are wearing masks. We have some family members where there is a student at home online and the other sibling is face to face.

Elementary Principal:

Enrollment is 145 students Pre-k through grade 5. Ninety three students are face to face and the others are distant learning. I am encouraging families with students who are struggling on line to come face to face. Lunch is in the classrooms.
