Two certified staff have quit and moved away. The 5th grade will have a long-term sub in the classroom. We have a teacher who will teach Middle School math and perhaps 6th grade. We have a teacher who is on FMLA for 12 weeks. We will fill that position with a teacher and a licensed sub. January 13th will be an early out for Professional Development-MTSS.

There was no school at the Elementary on the 15th due to a water break. Plumbers will be here Monday January 18th. There is no school that day. Have been following HB1027, HB1028 and HB1075 in legislature.

The High School is 75% face to face and the Elementary is around 70% face to face.

High School Principal:

Visited with families of Senior students who are behind and what plans have been implemented to help them catch up.

The teachers have come up with a new assignment plan and it is for grades 6-12. We have Power hour after school Monday through Thursday.

National Honor Society is selling coffee in the mornings (Braves Brew) from 8am to 9am.
Three students have earned their college Algebra credit and are now in Pre-Calculus. We have 3 people working on the Library. Two teachers and a person on an internship who is organizing the Library. We had a student who scored her 1000 points.
