Superintendent Report:

We are about 75% through our budget. We have only received 10% of our payment from Impact Aid. We will receive the remaining 90% in May. Working on the budget for the 2021-2022 School year. Book study syllabus has been sent to Minot State. Teachers will receive one credit. We will be meeting on Wednesdays for the next six weeks. Have also started working on the PD calendar for next year. Early out is next Wednesday and there will be SFA training and CPR training. March 18 and 19 is spring break. Foundation Aid will not be increasing in the next 2 years. Parshall will be receiving around \$300,000 in new CARES money, but there is no criteria at this point.

High School Principal:

Two more seniors are on track to graduate. ACT testing will be March 3<sup>rd</sup>. State testing will be in the next couple weeks. A group of students will be going to South Prairie to participate in Academic Olympics on March 24<sup>th</sup>.

Elementary Principal:

Attendance has been improving. Last week was Dress Up days. Literacy night will be held in two sessions to allow for spacing. We are encouraging parents to sign Up. Board members are invited to come and help out during Literacy night. After Spring break we will be having Real Heroes Reading Week. We have invited Dr., Nurses and EMT, Firemen, Dentist, Policemen come in and read to the students.

Final teacher evaluations have been started and will be complete by April 15<sup>th</sup>. State Assessment will start April 7<sup>th</sup>. The last 2 weeks of school we will do AimsWeb testing. Elementary Principal does have a recommendation for a non-renewal of a teacher.
